## Bookings and Waitlist

Places are allocated in the order that **all** completed forms are received. This includes any required medical forms. Days may be fully booked prior to the closure of bookings. We will commence a waitlist for days once capacity has been reached.

#### Pack a Healthy Lunch

Children are required to bring a packed lunch and refillable water bottle. Please make sure you pack enough food for morning tea, lunch, and afternoon tea.

When packing your child's lunch, please do not pack any food containing nuts. We have children at our services that are allergic and/or at risk of anaphylaxis. Fruit is always available.

#### What Children Wear

Children need to wear comfortable, sun safe clothes. Please no tank tops or shoestring straps as this leaves them too exposed to the sun.

Sports shoes are recommended so children can participate in all activities.

Please remember to pack a warm jacket, raincoat and spare underwear and pants if you think it may be required.

Please make sure that clothing has your child's name on it so we can return any items left at the service.

When going on excursions children are required to have on or packed in their bag the appropriate footwear and clothing as listed on the booking form for safety reasons.

## Medical Conditions and Additional

#### Support Needs

If your child has a medical condition or requires additional support while at our holiday program, please make sure you have indicated this on your booking form.

If your child requires medication, care will only be provided if we have the medication at the service and the medication is in date.

Medication **must** be collected from ASC/BSC at the end of term if it is required for Holiday Care. We will need to be informed immediately if there are any changes to your child's medical or support needs from the information provided on your 2024 enrolment form.

#### Technology/Phones/Smart Watches

Please do not send any devices to the service. We will not be responsible for any damage or loss of items at our programs. If you need to get in touch with your child, you can contact the service and they will pass on a message.

## Changes to the Program

Clarence Children's Services reserves the right to cancel or change excursions and in-house activities when circumstances such as weather conditions, venue cancellations or other circumstances beyond our control indicate this is necessary. If a change is made, we will endeavour to notify families as soon as is possible.
